# Timeline and Procedures

- Schedule cards have now been distributed!
- Lost schedule cards can be replaced by your academic/college counselor.
- Students need to schedule a meeting with Ms. Mercante (rising 10th), Mrs. Morgan (rising 11th) or their college counselor to finalize course selections for next year. **The schedule card will be filled out during the meeting**, and sent home for parent/caregiver signature following that meeting. Cards need to be returned to the student's academic/college counselor no later than **Monday, April 15**.
- Scheduling priority will be given to cards turned in on time.

## Schedule Policies

**Six Credit Policy:** Students are expected to take a minimum of 6 credits of courses.

**Seven Credit Policy:** Students may only take 7 full-time credits with permission from counselors and parent.

**Four AP Policy:** No student is permitted to take more than the equivalent of 4 AP credits, with the exception that AP Computer Science is permitted as a fifth AP credit.
